BGCA Golf Sponsorship Opportunities

Below is a description of the many sponsorship opportunities. Please fill out your form below and submit with payment to the BGCA PO Box.

BEER CART (1):

\$500.00 — We need one sponsor for the beer cart because there is only one cart and only one sponsor representative will be able to ride on the cart with the course driver. We will prepare a sign for the beer cart to be affixed to the cart announcing the sponsor. The cart will travel the full length of the course during the tournament.

BEER STATION (2):

\$350 – We have two opportunities for this new sponsorship. A beer station will be a space set up somewhere near the middle of each half of the course where beer/drinks will be accessible. We will prepare a sign to announce the sponsor of the beer station. A representative from the sponsor vendor may set up at this station and would be responsible for that set up but the beer/drinks/cooler will be provided by the course.

HOLE SPONSORSHIP (multiple sponsorship opportunities):

\$150 – a representative of the sponsor vendor may set up a tent and/or table at the sponsored hole (not provided) and a sign will be provided to announce the sponsor whether a representative is present or not. If a vendor sponsors a hole plus a full team of four golfers, the least expensive golfer will be free. This fee will also include lunch/dinner for one (1) representative. Others must pay extra lunch/dinner fee.

CONTEST HOLE SPONSORSHIP (5 sponsorship opportunities on a first come, first available basis):

\$50 plus cost of the prize – there are contests for longest putt, closest to the pin for men, closest to the pin for women, longest drive for men and longest drive for women. The sponsor is responsible for providing the prize for the contest and is welcome to have a representative on the contest hole to monitor the contest. A sign acknowledging the sponsor will be provided. The representative will need to be set up somewhere other than the tee box if another vendor has already sponsored the hole itself

SNACK SPONSORS (2 sponsorship opportunities on a first come, first available basis):

\$100.00 — sponsors can provide the goodie bags themselves or simply items to place in the goodie bags. Sponsors can also provide the snacks if they choose or those can be provided by BGCA. Signs acknowledging sponsorship will be provided.
