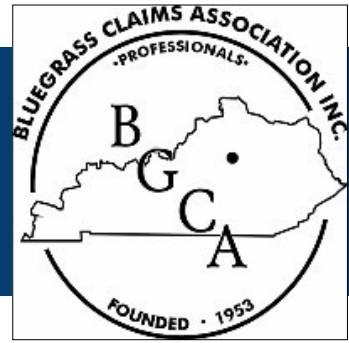
- Develop & engage in philanthropic strategy & outreach to meet and enhance program goals
